June 3, 10, 17, 24 Oregon Concealed Handgun License Training Fee \$40.00

This course meets the training requirements for an Oregon Concealed Handgun License. This three hour course consists of Handgun safety, Oregon Statutes 161 & 166, threat assessment and selection of safety equipment. A handgun is not required for this course.

June 3 State of Oregon Employee Health Fair, Host: Dept of Education

June 5 CHL - Personal Security I CHL Fee \$40.00 Personal Security I Fee \$75.00

This course requires pre-registration.

At 8:00 CHL for Oregon: This course meets the training requirements for an Oregon Concealed Handgun License This course consists of Handgun safety, Oregon Statutes 161 & 166, threat assessment and selection of safety equipment. A handgun is not required for this portion of the course. **At 12:30 PS1:** (Prerequisite - completion of CHL for Oregon) This is 4+ hours of range experience that teaches the use of a handgun with an introduction to two-handed default shooting, strong hand and support hand shooting techniques. It also covers handgun selection, fit, grip, and sight alignment, trigger control and follow through. Required: a handgun*, 100 rounds of Full Metal Jacket ammunition, ear protection, wrap around eye protection, baseball cap and a shirt that is snug to the throat. *If you do not already have a handgun of your own, you do not need to purchase one just to take the class. There will be handguns available to rent for \$40.00 and this includes ammunition and cleaning of the gun. This course exceeds Oregon's training requirements for a Concealed Handgun License.

June 6 Utah Concealed Firearm Permit Training Fee \$110.00

This course requires pre-registration.

A non-resident Utah Concealed Firearm Permit will allow concealed carry in 30 other states, including Washington. Upon completion of this course, the permit application process can all be done by mail and the permit is valid for 5 years. The fee for this class includes all of the required application materials, along with a large pre-addressed envelope to send them to Utah. You will get a passport quality photo, and a blue finger print card with your prints rolled by a qualified technician and have a copy made of your driver's license.

If you were the only thing standing between several brutal criminals and your family, would you trust your current skills to protect them? Having a concealed handgun license does not guarantee you will survive a violent encounter. It is not enough to train just with your self-defense firearm when confronted with hardened criminals. You must have some form of hand-to-hand close quarter tactics to defend against your attacker who has closed the distance to less than arms reach literally arresting your options to draw your concealed firearm since they need to be this close to assault/rob/abduct/rape/etc.

In this eight-hour class, you will learn essential skills to deal with close quarter assaults including positions of disadvantage. Emphasis is placed on transitioning from empty hand defense to your concealed firearm, Kubaton or Gunting/LLC.

This class is a prerequisite for CQB level 2, which is a two-day course, one-day hands on classroom, one day on the range.

Requires

- Concealment rig (optional if your primary defensive tool is not a firearm)

· Dress in Regular Street clothes which makes the training realistic as we fight as we train.

July 11 & 12 Defensive Rifle 201 with Georges Rahbani \$295.00

Georges Rahbani was born in the Middle East (Lebanon). During years of brutal civil battles, skill at arms wasn't a recreational privilege - it was an *actual necessity of daily survival*. The lessons he learned in actual conflicts - about guns, their effectiveness, and their ability to keep oneself alive while defending family and neighborhood - have become important cornerstones of his unique instruction.

After becoming a U.S. Citizen, Georges attended classes at the best schools - Gunsite, Thunder Ranch, Chapman Academy, Lethal Force Institute (LFI), Firearms Academy of Seattle, Jim Cirillo, and Chuck Taylor. He found each had a piece of the puzzle to prepare the dedicated rifle student for serious encounters, but none had combined them into a coherent whole. He filtered those doctrines through his own extensive experience; the result is what may be the best preparation the serious practitioner of the ultimate martial art can get: "The Fighting Rifle."

Georges is a member of ASLET ILEETA (International Law Enforcement Educators and Trainers Association), holds certifications from the National Law Enforcement Training Center (NLETC) and the NRA, and has held certifications from the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission.

Defensive Rifle 201: Controlling The Rifle

"Controlling The Rifle", the start of "The Fighting Rifle" series, teaches you the mechanics of effective rifle fire. It is a two day, intermediate level course of 800 rounds designed for the dedicated shooter who wants a good grounding in rifle technique for both self-defense and hunting. This class concentrates on the finer points of platforms, manipulation, sighting, and trajectory from which all "tactical" shooting is done. This isn't a beginning or introductory class

- it is a foundational course focusing on the skills that must be mastered by all serious shooters. Novice or veteran, you will learn some “new tricks”!

One of the most valuable parts of Level 240 is the opportunity to diagnose errors that limit your ultimate performance. (One student, a multiple graduate of several very well-known shooting schools, remarked that in all of his training no one ever explained how to manipulate the trigger in a manner that made sense to him. His scores improved dramatically just from this one class topic!)

Part of controlling your rifle is handling it safely. You’ll be introduced to a new way of looking at safety, which Georges calls a “safety attitude.” It will permanently alter how you handle firearms! He’ll show you how traditional safety rules, as commonly presented, actually set you up for an accident - and what to do to avoid falling into the traps. You’ll come away with the beginnings of a subconscious commitment to safe gun handling that will serve you in the field as well as on the range.
